

How have schools been using GoChinese? As a customisable, language-focused course delivery platform

1 Introductory courses that link to UK QCA recognised qualifications

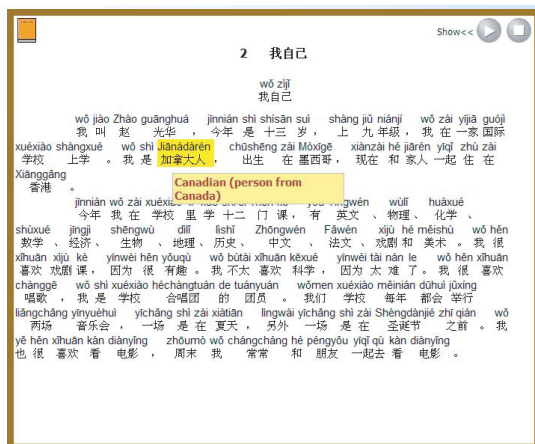
Language Colleges and independent schools have been offering Entry Level 'Practical' and 'Business' Chinese courses on GoChinese. These courses lead to QCA recognised qualifications, for which much of the internal assessment is conducted through [exams that are pre-approved and automarked on the platform](#). The focus is on speaking and listening skills. The courses also incorporate some 'for interest only' vocabulary, matching the profile of the learner (e.g., 'Marks and Spencer' for UK based learners). [Instructors can also modify the course materials at any time](#). Over 95% of students have successfully obtained this qualification, with a number of them awarded 'Distinction' and 'Merit.'

3 Instructor-created courses

Instructors have been creating a wide range of learning materials on GoChinese -- from [reading passage featuring Chinese celebrities](#) (see the 'As an effective resource to motivate learning' case study) to lessons and exercises for the IB curriculum. At the **German Swiss International School** in Hong Kong, GCSE students are encouraged to review reference writing passages created by the teacher as well as submit their own writing.

GoChinese also offers an Introductory Chinese Resource Pack - for Key Stage 3/4, providing vocabulary focused learning materials, supplemented with listening, reading and sentence structure exercises.
